

To be seen in your home by one of the At Home Podiatry doctors, you must be considered homebound or home limited as well as have a referral.

What is homebound and home-limited?

Homebound and home-limited mean you are either unable to leave home or have a very difficult time leaving home due to an illness or injury and leaving home could cause your health to get worse. If you require a wheelchair or an assistive device such as a walker or wheelchair, require special transportation, require help from another person to leave home, or you have a medical reason why leaving home would take considerable effort or worsen your condition, you are likely considered homebound or home-limited.

Referrals

It is the policy of At Home Podiatry to have a referral prior to seeing any patient in their home. We accept referrals from another physician treating the patient, home health agencies, CICOA or a patient's case manager. For patients that are seen in our office, a referral is not required unless required by the patient's insurance such as an HMO.
